WHAT TO CONSIDER WHEN WANTING A FIRST LOOK SESSION

What is a first look session? A first look session allows for the couple to have the unique opportunity to spend an intimate moment together. In this session, the bride reveals her wedding dress to her lover in a private manner that is captured in photo and/or film. This moment allows for the couple to fully embrace each other and their new adventure in life. There are two ways a first look moment can be scheduled, before the wedding day or on the wedding day. This decision is personal to yours and your partner's preference and has thoughts that should be considered before making the final decision.

Are you wanting to schedule your first look session before your wedding date? If so, there are three things that need to be considered. The first, and most important, is your photographer and videographers turn around time. This is a question and conversational topic that needs to happen when discussing first looks. By knowing the turnaround time, you are then able to move forward with finding a fitting date for your first look session. This is important because if you are wanting to display your first look pictures and/or video on your wedding day, you need to allow for enough time in-between the first look and wedding dates to allow for that to happen. For example, if your photographer and videographers turn around time is 4 weeks, you should schedule your first look at least 6 weeks before your wedding date. This allows for not only enough time for your wedding vendors to give you their products, but enough time to get the pictures printed and the video transferred. The second thing to be considered is the flexibility that scheduling your first looks previous to your wedding date allows.

The weather is something that neither the photographer, videographer, or other wedding vendors can control. Unlike your wedding day, if the weather prevents your first look session from occurring, you can easily and quickly reschedule. In turn, if you are having an outdoor wedding and the weather is bad that day, you have your first look pictures and video to reflect on. Of course you will still receive those cherished wedding day photos and films, but you also have beautiful photos of the two of you without drenched hair and runny makeup. The last thought to be considered is location. Scheduling first looks before your wedding day opens the idea of capturing you and your partner with a breathtaking background. If you are unable to have a destination wedding due to various reasons, you still have the opportunity to have a destination first look.





Are you wanting to keep your wedding day special, but would like to still have that intimate moment of a first look? If you answered yes, then there are two things to consider. The first is scheduling enough time before the start of your ceremony. A minimum of 45 minutes would give an acceptable amount of time to share your first look and capture other special moments together before your ceremony. Remember, sharing your first look is a special and intimate moment. The worst thing that could happen is not allowing for enough time to share that moment with each other. Talking with your photographer and videographer is highly recommended as they can direct you in scheduling. A second idea to consider when capturing your first look before your ceremony is the locations that your venue offers. You may be able to choose to do it at your wedding altar. This location choice would make it special for the reason that that will be the spot you and your partner get married and share your first kiss as husband and wife. The other location thought is considering the surrounding landscapes or backgrounds that your venue offers. Whether your venue is in the mountains or on the beach, you should consider the different areas within your venue that best fits your dream.

Are you getting married in a temple, but wanting to share a first look with your significant other on your wedding day? An option to consider so you can have this intimate moment is exiting out of a different door than where your family and friends will be waiting. You will first need to talk with a temple coordinator to see if there is another door in which you are able to exit privately. If so, the groom will walk out first where the photographer or videographer will place him then notify the bride. The two of you are then able to have and share that moment privately. The couple then can walk back inside the temple and walk out the door where they will celebrate with their family and friends.

By scheduling a first look session, you are giving you and your partner the opportunity to share an intimate moment. When choosing the best time to schedule your first look, you want to consider all of the options shared above. Have an open conversation with your partner, photographer, and videographer to find the option that makes your wedding dreams come alive. However and whenever you schedule your first look session, you will cherish that moment for many years to come.


